

Racing Numbers.

1. Racing numbers will be allocated when enrolling with a club.
2. Numbers must be displayed on both sides of the vehicle.
3. Numbers must be of a contrasting colour to the main colour of the racecar.
4. Numbers must be of a minimum 10 inches high with a stroke width minimum of 1.5 inches.
5. The club prefix must also be displayed before the number, minimum of 4 inches high (102mm).
6. Prefix letters for Southern Autosport Association - S.
7. Prefix letters for Standlake Arena - X
8. Prefix letters for Tongham Motor Club - T
9. Prefix letters for Rolling Thunder Show -R
10. Prefix letter for ORC (Worthing) - W
11. All cars must have a white roof fin fitted above the gutter line.
12. The roof fin must be white.
13. Roof fin club prefix must be black and a minimum 4 inches (102mm) high, with a stroke width minimum of 1/2 an inch (12.5mm).
14. Roof fin numbers must be black and a minimum and 6 inches (152mm) high, and minimum stroke width 1 inch (25mm).
15. The group name must be displayed on the passenger's side front roof corner minimum 4 inches (102mm) high.
16. Specials may display a solid black club prefix and number on a white roof fin or white end plates of spoiler if fitted, as large as possible, prefix minimum of 4 inches (102mm) high, with a stroke width of 1/2 an inch (12.5mm). Numbers minimum 6 inches (152mm) high, stroke width minimum of 1 inch (25mm).
17. Only the appropriate numbers shall be displayed during practice and racing.
18. Other numbers must be adequately covered or removed altogether.
19. The driver's name must be displayed on the car.
